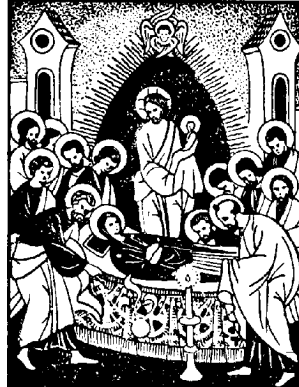

The Tenth Sunday after Pentecost, Resurrectional Tone 1; Our Venerable Mother Macrina, Sister of St. Basil the Great (380)

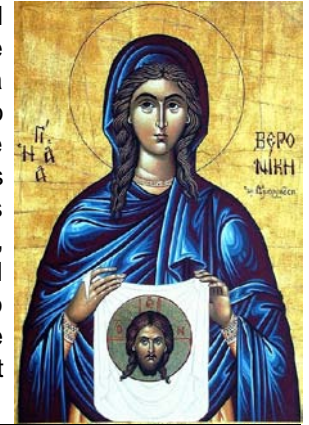

TODAY'S FEAST: Our Venerable Mother Veronica (Bernice) is seen first in the New Testament as the hemorrhaging woman (Matthew 9, Mark 5, Luke 8). Church tradition tells us that she later had a statue made of

Jesus with His arms outstretched. She would pray before it, and it was preserved until the time of Julian the Apostate, when it was turned into a statue of Zeus. She is also the woman who wiped the sweat from the face of Jesus as he carried His Cross to Calvary. The image of His face was left upon the cloth, and she carried this with her on her missionary work. In France, Emperor Tiberias was healed of a terminal disease when he looked at it. This cloth, also known as Veronica's Veil, is housed at the Vatican and shown on many dates throughout the year.
