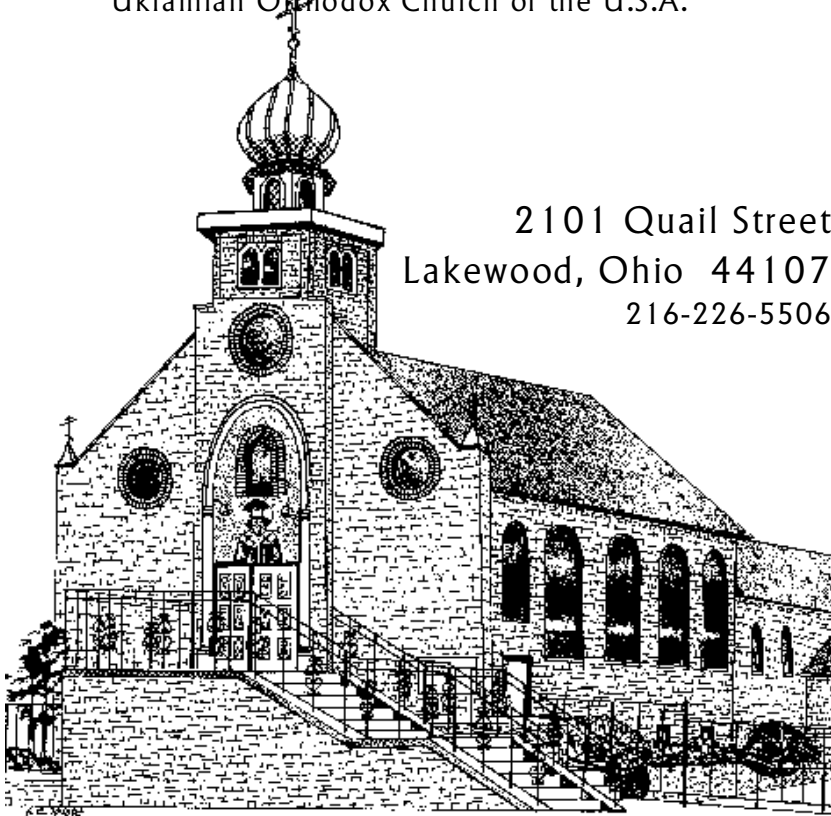

**TODAY'S FEAST: The Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee** is so named because the Gospel Reading for this Sunday is taken from Luke 18:10-14, the parable of the Tax Collector (Publican) and the Pharisee. The Orthodox Church begins the pre-Lenten period of preparation with this Sunday. We are invited to take a deeper look inside ourselves, to search our souls and realize our need for God's mercy. We are called to acknowledge our sins and fall before God in repentance making the Publican's prayer our own: God, be merciful to me a sinner.

A unique feature of this first week of the Triodion is that it is a **Fast-Free Week** which includes Wednesday and Friday. The Church prepares us to prepare for the Great Fast by exempting us from all fasting.
